Thank you so much for working with this us on this important event, and as I told Rep. Lucas, thank the Governor for her willingness to participate.

The event is the dedication of Coker College's new 2,000-seat Harris E. and Louise H. DeLoach Athletic Center.

The event will start at 10 a.m. and the agenda with all speakers and tours will likely go for an hour. There is a reception as well.

Dr. Robert Wyatt, president of Coker College, will be the master of ceremonies and say a few words.

We would likely have Dr. Wyatt introduce the Governor at the beginning of the program. (Would it be OK for us to tell people in advance that she is coming? We are inviting approximately 200 to 300 people, most donors to Coker College as well as college students. There will also be area news media.)

I would see the Governor speaking about the dedication of this important new facility on the Coker Campus and then announce the Order of the Palmetto for Harris DeLoach.

Harris would speak directly after receiving the award (**he does not know that he's receiving the award** and is only prepared to talk about the dedication.)

The Governor can certainly leave after that part of the program so at maximum no more than 15-20 minutes, but probably less.

Attached is some background on the new facility. It is located on the Coker College Campus between 3<sup>rd</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>

Street off of Railroad Avenue just outside of downtown Hartsville. I will forward you a map and the invitation when it's finished.

The Governor can be driven directly to the entrance of the Athletic Center and will be met by Coker and Sonoco representatives. There will also be Campus security available.

Let me know if you need any further information. I've attached my contact information and the contact information of Barb Steadman, College Secretary and Dr. Wyatt's chief of staff.)
