WHEREAS, the Lions Candy Days donation drive helps fund the SC Lions Mobile Health Screening Unit, eye examinations, eye surgeries, eye glasses, and hearing aids for people in need as well as an international youth exchange program and two camps for blind children in South Carolina; and

WHEREAS, "South Carolina Lions Sight and Hearing Conservation Week," October 7 - 12, 2013, will coincide with "Lions World Sight Day" on October 10, 2013, and include the annual Lions Candy Days donation drive.
