Dear Governor Haley,



It doesn't mention anywhere in this report where I was begging the two (2) firemen who came into my home without any hat or gas mask on to please save my animals. I was totally ignored by them and now I feel as if I was totally ignored by your office.

Lexington Fire crews arrived at the incident location and reported heavy fire from the primary structure and fire extending to trees, a shed and a exposure house located to the D-side of the primary structure. Concerned citizens in the street advised command there was a possible victim located in the exposure structure located at 125 Miranda. Ladder 5 crew was assigned Search and Rescue @ 125 and E-12 was assigned to water supply for Ladder 5. The Ladder 5 crew was able to locate the victim who was asleep in the living room area along the interior B-side wall of the structure. When the Ladder 5 crew located the victim the exterior wall of the structure was involved and the fire was extending into the house. Water supply was established using the local hydrant and mobile water supply with several apparatus. The fires at both properties were extinguished and a extensive salvage and overhaul operation took place.

The primary structure appeared to be rental property and was vacant at the time of the incident.

The exposure structure received heavy damage from the incident. In addition to the victim crews were able to rescue 5 dogs from the structure that were alive. These animals were turned over to the owner. *7 dogs outside - all lived*

Lexington SO completed a incident report (15-005911)

The fire in the primary structure appeared to have started in the living room area located at the A/D side of the structure.

Did not mention about me saving my Blind 20 year Old dachshund or cut a birds.

Dear Governor Haley,

I am attaching a fire report that happened on April 1, 2015 around 10:-10-30 p.m. This report is not totally correct.

On April 1, 2015 I was asleep on my sofa when two (2) men came into my house and woke me up and said my house was on fire. What had happened is the house next door to me had caught on fire (they think it is arson) and it caught my dog house which was a 12x16 on fire and then it did start to move to my house. When these two (2) men came in the only had on their fire jacket and helmet. It was a warm night and I had two windows up about 4 inches. I did see some flames but at that time I think they were on the dog house. There was no smoke in my house. My fire alarms had not even gone off.

I had a 20 year old blind dachshund dog who always laid in a chair by me (approximately around 8 inches from my head) and a cat who was asleep on my lap. I also had two (2) birds that was in an a joining room but I knew they could not be saved. I asked the two men to let me get my dog and cat which would have taken 5 seconds to pick each up in my arms but instead they grabbed me by the arm and made me leave my animals. I kept begging them to go back in there and get them but they refuse to do so. As I had said earlier there was no smoke whatsoever in the house so my animals could have been saved. At that time if it was so bad why did I not have to use oxygen. There was nothing in the report about me begging them to let me get my animals or please help me get them. And also if it was so bad why did they not have their oxygen mask on. After I got outside it took them about 10 minutes to get the water on. They did try to put my house out first because I did live there and the other house was empty.

I thank God that I am safe but my animals could be alive today if these two(2) firemen would have had a little compassion. Outside the fireman were all sitting around doing nothing while they tried to get the water going.

I am 62 years old and have never had any children. These were my children. I also had seven dogs that lived outside but thankfully they all made it.

Governor Haley, I really need to know who these men were. They were wrong, so wrong. I called the main office at 122 Ball Park Road, Lexington, South Carolina yesterday and ask for the head

person. They said he was off yesterday but would be back to work today. I called today and they said he was on vacation. I think his last name is Gardner. In the report it says that South Congaree was the first firemen to appear at the scene so I am assuming that the two (2) fireman who would not give me thirty seconds to save my dog and cat. I mean no harm to them. I just need to look at them at tell them how heartless they are and I need to do this for my pets.

I have several friends that work with Richland County Fire Departments, all at different stations and everyone of them said that this matter with my pets was handled in careless manner.

I beg of you, please help me.
