Danny,

Her case was reviewed by the Panel this week. I have attached the decision that was mailed out yesterday. The Panel affirmed the administrative hearing officer's decision against her holding her indefinitely disqualified in that she voluntarily quit without good cause. Ms Holtzclaw will have to appeal to the Administrative Law Court for judicial review. She has 30 days from the mailing date to do this. If she wins her appeal at court, she would be paid retroactively. Otherwise, she must return to work and earn eight times her weekly benefit amount and then separated through no fault of her own (lack of work etc.).
