TIDBIT! While walking along a trail at a South Carolina State Park this winter, you may hear a high-pitched "tsee tsee tsee tsee" sound in the trees. This is the sound of the golden-crowned kinglet, a tiny bird of northern boreal forests that comes down south for the winter. Look into the trees above you, and watch for this busy bird as it flits constantly in search of insects and insect eggs. One January when Paris Mountain's Lake Placid bore a sheet of ice, we saw golden-crowned kinglets hopping on the ice. They were not eating, just sort of skating! They are known for this curious behavior.
