Conveys: All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being near the Camden Road in the suburbs of Columbia, County of Richland, State of South Carolina, containing one-half acre, more or less, and bounding and butting as follows: Towards the North and East on land of R.W. Smith; South on lands of Turner and Thompson, and West on land of Thompson and Campbell.

NOTE: The abstractor is unable to ascertain how the grantor, Jane Davis, acquired title to this property. The lot described is a portion of the two large lots conveyed by William Wallace, Trustee, to Peter Davis, in Link I above. No conveyance of this lot was ever made by Peter Davis and the assumption is that the interest of Peter Davis in this particular lot passed in some manner to Jane Davis, but that link is completely missing. In other conveyances by Peter Davis, Jane Davis renounced dower, sometimes signing Anna Jane Davis. Peter Davis was not dead at the time of this deed, there being on record instruments executed by him subsequently.

This missing link constitutes a defect in the title to part of the property herein abstracted but it is a defect which, in the opinion of the abstractor, has been cured by the passage of time. R.W. Smith, his heirs and devisees, have had record color of title to this property from 1895 to date and have acquired thereby good title by adverse possession.

The will of R. W. Smith was admitted to probate in common form August 20th, 1906, and Letters Testamentary issued to Edward W. Smith on the same date. The will is properly executed and witnessed and bears date Nov. 16, 1903. By item



2 all property, real and personal, is left to Testator's wife, Elizabeth Smith, for her natural life. Item 3 bequeaths the personal property, after the death of his wife, to testator's six children in equal shares. Item 4 provides: "After the death of my wife, I give, devise and bequeath my real estate to my children in the following manner: "\* \* \* To my daughter, Sydney C. Goley, I give, devise and bequeath in fee simple the vacant lot South of my home place, which lot is bounded on the North by my home place, by lot of Mrs. Goley and by lot above devised to my daughter, Elizabeth C. Gates.

NOTE 1: Under the above will, Sydney C. Goley acquired fee simple title in xxx remainder, subject to the life estate of Mrs. Elizabeth Smith, testator's wife. In a statement made in the office of Robinson & Robinson on May 24, 1933, Sydney C. Goley stated that her mother, Elizabeth Smith, had been dead at that time for seven years. An affidavit to this effect can be obtained.

NOTE 2: The chains of tracts A and B bring title to the property described in the caption of this abstract into Sydney C. Goley, subject to the defects mentioned above being cured. The second described lot in the caption is, however, so irregular in shape that it is difficult to state accurately whether it all came out of the lot described as V. under Tract B, or lot described as II. in Tract A. In either case, however, the will of R. W. Smith vested good title in Sydney C. Goley.

#### ENCUMBRANCES.

We find no mortgages, lis pendens, judgments, mechanics liens, or other liens, on or affecting the title to this property.



TAXES

All taxes, State, County and City, for the past ten years including the year 1938, have been regularly paid on this property.

OPINION
