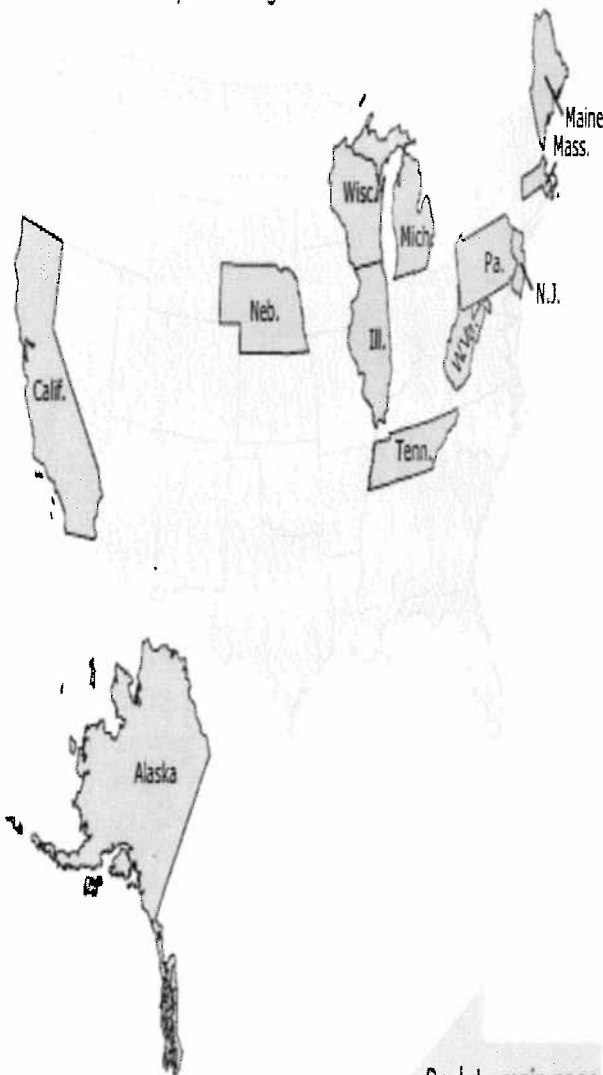

## The reduction veto



The reduction veto is only available to 12 governors and can be used only on budget bills.

## How it works

The reduction veto allows a governor to reduce the amounts budgeted for individual items. The governor's amendments can be overridden by the legislature.

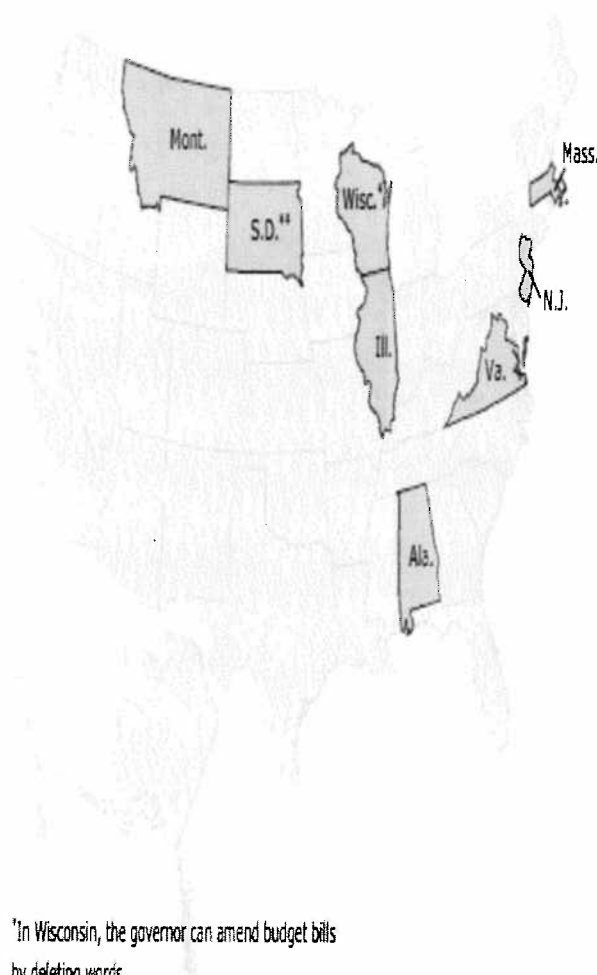

## The amendatory veto



The amendatory veto is only available to eight governors.



\*In Wisconsin, the governor can amend budget bills by deleting words

\*\*In South Dakota, the governor can only use an amendatory veto when the Legislature is in session

The amendatory veto allows a governor to revise bills after they have been approved by the legislature. Any revisions made by the governor are subject to confirmation or rejection by the state legislatures.
