If these vulnerable adults are unable to stay home and move to a nursing home or an assisted living facility, they would also be under the jurisdiction of the LGOA. As South Carolina’s aging population continues to grow, we have also seen an increase in cases of abuse. But unfortunately we often do not have the capacity within facilities to adequately care for these adults if they need to be moved out of their home or to a different facility. If Adult Protective Services were to receive additional funding, this should be the number one priority.”
