Brad and Patrick,

Thanks for the meeting this afternoon. The side-by-sides that we discussed today are attached. As I mentioned in our meeting and the Governor mentioned in her meeting with House leaders last week, the top 10 items in the side-by-side are reforms that our office has supported throughout the Ethics Reform debate; however, at a minimum, we believe any ethics reform bill must (1) include independent investigations of public officials; (2) include broad private income disclosures; and (3) should not weaken current ethics laws.
