WHEREAS, the Celebrate My Drive teen driver awareness safety campaign encourages all new teen drivers to celebrate their newly acquired licenses and driving privileges as well as use caution, courtesy, and patience when driving; and

WHEREAS, Celebrate My Drive Day provides an opportunity for the community to support teens everywhere as they learn to drive and prepare for the road ahead.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim September 15, 2012, as
