I had no other. I'm writing
you in regards of my
daughter, Christa Brown.
She is incarcerated at
the Cherokee County
Detention Center here in
Daffney. She has been since
September 25, 2015. The Asst.
Solicitor, Kim Beskewic
padded her case and
brought up everything she
has done. The reason she
did this is because she
had a personal vendetta
against her and me. I talked
for my child because she
has a drug problem, and
the Asst. Solicitor wanted

her to go to prison. She refused to give her Army Court or any help for her problem. On September 22, 2015 my daughter went to have a warrant recorded, out of 12 people who had warrants recorded for leaving Court too early she was the only one who Judge Couch put a monitor on and Judge Couch told her to shut-up she couldn't say anything in her own defence. Judge Couch told her she could not go anywhere not even Church. There her Civil Rights were violated; she could not even look for employment. Her public Defender Michael Berry did not come to her defence because Christa

Had written a letter to
the Council on Judicial
Conduct on him. Michael
Berry and the Asst. Solicitor
conspired together to pad
her cases, this is why
Judge Couch did this to
her. Probation and parole
ordered her to have Mental
Health and Drug Rehab
the Asst. Solicitor would
not let her out to attend.
Will you please intervene so
that Christa can get the
help she needs. As you know
Cherokee County has the most
corrupt government and
police and Sheriff
department in the State
of S.C. I know but I
cannot prove it but there
some Black young men that

are selling crack on the street and they never go to jail. Chunta needs all the help she can get so that she can become a working citizen again. She has (3) children, one just graduated from the University of S.C. with honors, her name is Laria Brown class of 2015. Her son is a junior at Southern Wesleyan University. Her youngest daughter is a freshman at Frances Marion University. Her son's name is Shaquille Brown, her youngest daughter's name is Malika Brown. When she was not in jail, she did work parttime at KK's daycare. Yonemor baby she only

need a chance to show
that she is worthy of a
second chance, her children
need her, they are doing
so well and I need her
also. I was just released
from the Hospital on 9/8/15
with a blood clot in my
right lung, plus pneumonia.
I'm doing O.K. now, I still
have days when I can't walk
because of severe nerve
damage to my back. I'm
not worried about myself
anymore (67) now, I only want
it to be made possible
so that if I die, Christa
will be a responsible
working citizen to take
care of her family and
to do the right thing as
a citizen of S.C. and the

United States. please take
my letter in consideration
and look into this matter.
