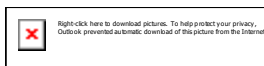

Prior to their academy graduation, they will have successfully completed testing regimens which are more difficult than the actual IAI Certified Latent Print Examiner Test. As soon as they have fulfilled the experience requirements, they will be prepared to apply for certification through the International Association for Identification.



To be accepted into the academy, all student applicants will have to meet stringent educational and ethical standards, along with passing a background

investigation, and complete a visual acuity examination that is specifically designed to determine if they possess the natural skills to become a latent print examiner. Through our past experiences, we have determined that it really does not matter how hard a person is willing to work at becoming a latent print examiner if they cannot discern what they observe in impression evidence.

The academy will be held at the Southern Regional Public Safety Institute, which is located on the grounds of Camp Shelby, a state owned and operated Joint Forces Training Facility for military personnel and law enforcement. Camp Shelby is a few miles south of Hattiesburg, MS and is just one hour north of the beautiful Mississippi Gulf Coast.



Students will be housed on base in one person hotel rooms with access to internet, cable TV, housekeeping services, gym and pool facilities, laundry facilities, tennis, camping, fishing, etc., along with three hot meals per day. The housing, meals and access to all base facilities are included in the academy tuition, with minimal fees for optional amenities. Personal transportation for each student is the responsibility of the student or sponsoring agency.

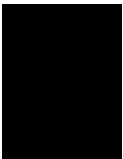
