We would like to congratulate Governor Haley on her nomination as U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations and would like to request an interview with her to discuss the priorities of the Trump administration in foreign policy and at the U.N. In particular, we are interested in discussing how the next administration will approach North Korea and Syria in the U.N. as well as her expectations for Japan's role in the Security Council.
