Honorable Governor Haley:

On February 18, 2013 at the Chester County Council Meeting our Council requested that a letter be sent to your office regarding the closing of the Chester Workforce Office on February 15, 2013.

We strongly disagree with this decision for several reasons: (1) Chester County has one of the highest unemployment rates in the State; (2) AN UNDUE HARDSHIP ON Chester County residents traveling 30 miles – one way – to the Lancaster County office; (3) the increased price of gasoline rising everyday as much as ten cent per gallon; and (4) many do not have transportation and rely on others for a ride.

Our Vice Chairman, Mr. Branham, suggested that a representative from Lancaster County Workforce Center travel to the Chester County office one or two days a week to handle Chester County residents in place of 30 or 40 residents traveling to Lancaster County each week.

Any consideration you can provide to aid our residents would greatly be appreciated in this urgent matter.
