Dear Governor Haley,

Enclosed are two pieces of correspondence originated by the undersigned. The February 2009 letter was written to numerous large organizations then inundating this address with solicitations for money and filling out surveys, the latter, which I usually did. I knew already what the newly elected President had in store for America and that he would be given a free pass from an already worshipping mainstream media. Thus, my contention to the many conservative organizations in February 2009 was that they needed to band together, communications-wise, if their message had any chance of having an impact.

The bridge between February 2009 and February 2015 to garner enough American unity is still a challenge. A divided people does not serve the interests of country, it only serves the political interests of those promoting it. The only real answer is to turn to states rights and form a band of brother governors and that is where this mailing, with a few exceptions, will be sent.

Lastly, this is not about me. I did serve on active duty for 29 years then taught school for 15, but I could care less about anything other than our great country waking up to where we are and what we're facing. Also, a resurgence of reverence and fear of our God would serve as an excellent catalyst in countering so much of what has gone awry with our traditional values.


To whom it may concern:
