It's been 232 years since the Revolutionary War ended and 150 years since the Civil War ended. Those that unfortunately want to fly Confederate flags on their personal property should be allowed to do so as that's a cost of the personal liberties that define America (having to endure things that we may not personally like but are within the bounds of freedom of expression).
