The building is divided into two main sections, separated by a heavy rectangular brick rib which extends past the main line of the façade. To the south of the demarcation rib lies the larger half of the building, which is accessed directly to the south of the rib via a set of double steel and glass doors. A bank of fixed steel- and aluminum-frame tinted windows covers the rest of the south side of the front elevation and wraps around on a portion of the south side elevation as well. These windows are canted from top to bottom, and a skirt wall planter wraps around beneath them in the added space. To the north of the rib lies the smaller half of the building, which roughly mirrors the southern half. A single wood door is located directly to the north of the rib and another band of canted steel frame windows wraps around the front and side elevations of the northern half of the building as well. The building has very deep overhanging boxed eaves which couple with the canted windows to create an extremely angular feel to the building, particularly at the corners.
