CALL TO ORDER / ATTENDANCE: The meeting was called to order at 10:02 a.m. by Panel Chair Karen Schwartz.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: A **motion** was made by Mr. Green to accept the April 12, 2016 Agenda. The motion was seconded by Ms. Rice and carried unanimously.

APPROVAL/DISAPPROVAL OF ABSENT PANEL MEMBER(S): No motion was made since all Panel Members were present.

WELCOME NEW PANEL ADMINISTRATOR: Introduction of April Koon. A **motion** was made by Ms. Wrenn and seconded by Mr. Green to authorize the Chair of the Panel to work with Administrator to come up with a delegation of authority matrix that can be presented at the next meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: A **motion** was made by Ms. Thomas to accept the September 18, 2015 minutes as written. The motion was seconded by Mr. Green and carried unanimously.

OFFICE OF INVESTIGATIONS & ENFORCEMENT (OIE) STATISTICAL REPORT: Althea Myers, Chief of Investigations and Enforcement, provided the OIE Statistical Report and a Training Report that listed training the OIE investigators have attended. The Panel accepted this as information.

INVESTIGATIVE REVIEW COMMITTEE (IRC) REPORT: Chief Myers provided the IRC Report to the Panel. There were no cases to be presented to the Panel.

OFFICE OF INVESTIGATIONS & ENFORCEMENT AND OFFICE OF DISCIPLINARY COUNSEL ORIENTATION: Chief Myers gave brief overview of how complaints are handled by the Office of Investigations and Enforcement. Ms. Shealey, Counsel for the Office of Disciplinary Counsel, gave a brief overview of how cases from the IRC are handled. Ms. Shealey noted that there were no disciplinary cases in ODC at this time.

LEGISLATIVE UPDATE: Ms. Beeson gave a brief summary of the legislative update on Regulation 40-8 for changing the CE to conform to the Commission on Dietetic Registration requirements. The changes have not yet been scheduled for a subcommittee hearing on the House or Senate side. It has 120 days to be taken up by the House and Senate. If it is not taken up by the House or Senate, it will go into effect on May 13, 2016. A **motion** was made by Ms. Wrenn for Ms. Beeson to work with staff to send an E-Blast to all licensees regarding the change in the Regulations. The motion was seconded by Mr. Greene and carried unanimously.

Ms. Beeson departed meeting.

Mr. Jennings, the Panel's Advice Counsel, gave a brief summary on the proposed revision to DHEC Regulations, S.C. Code of Regulations R. 61-16§ 1505. A **motion** was made by Ms. Rice to approved R. 61-16§ as amended and authorize it to be submitted to DHEC and for Mr. Jennings to work with Ms. Childers as the point of contact on those changes. The motion was seconded by Ms. Wrenn and carried unanimously.

APPLICATION HEARING – LICENSURE APPLICATION – JUAN REYNOSO: Mr. Reynoso's application was before the Panel as he indicated that he was a Qualified Alien or non-immigrant under the Federal Immigration and Nationality Act and is lawfully present in the United States. Because of this answer, staff submitted his application to LLR's Immigrant Worker Compliance Department. According to the *Systematic Alien Verification of Entitlement* or SAVE Report, Mr. Reynoso is a *Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals* or DACA qualifier. He cannot be considered for the state benefit of professional or occupational licensure according to an opinion by the South Carolina State Attorney General. Mr. Reynoso withdrew his application.

Executive Session (10:26 to 10:49 a.m.) A **motion** was made by Mr. Greene to go into Executive Session to receive legal advice. The motion was seconded by Ms. Thomas and carried unanimously. A **motion** was made by Ms. Rice to come out of Executive Session. The motion was seconded by Ms. Thomas and carried unanimously.

RICE: Ms. Rice gave a summary of the proposed change for professional Continuing Education (CEU) requirements under Regulation 40-8 (B) which currently states that all licensees must demonstrate compliance with the continuing education requirements consistent with the Commission on Dietetic Registration. Ms. Rice proposes that the Panel make a change to be in alignment with the Commission on Dietetic Registration which requires 75 hours of CEU's every five years. A **motion** was made by Ms. Childers for Mr. Jennings to work with Ms. Rice to draft language amending Regulation 40-8 and present changes at the next scheduled meeting. The motion was seconded by Mr. Greene and carried unanimously.

SUBJECT: REVISED TEST SPECIFICATIONS

Test specifications for both the entry-level Registration Examination for Dietitians and Registration Examination for Dietetic Technicians have been revised using the results of the CDR 2015 Dietetics Practice Audit. Examinations given after January 1, 2017 will reflect the new specifications. The current and revised test specifications for both entry-level examinations are enclosed with this mailing. The Study Outlines and Candidate Handbooks can be found on CDR's website; <https://www.cdrnet.org/program-director-registration-handbook-information>.

Test specifications are periodically updated by the Commission to remain in compliance with the *Standards for Educational and Psychological Testing*, the criteria used to evaluate the quality of credentialing and licensure examinations. This assists in ensuring that both the dietitian and dietetic technician examinations remain congruent with current practice. Study guides for both examinations are currently being updated. The study guides will include a study outline, practice examination and updated reference list. Purchasing information for the new study guide will be sent to licensure boards in September 2016.

CDR's Test Specification Development Committee included dietetics practitioners, employers and educators representing diverse practice, geographic and ethnic perspectives. The Committee considered the many CDR publics who use the test specification document in the development process. These include examination candidates, dietetics educators, licensure boards, employers, item writers and examination review committee members.

The test specification content domains, and the assigned weights, reflect the results of the 2015 Dietetics Practice Audit survey. Only entry-level activities and activities testable within our current format were considered for inclusion in the test specifications. It is important to note that dietetics education encompasses a much broader range of knowledge and skills than can be assessed on the registration examination.

Following test specification development, the existing pool of examination items were reclassified according to the new test specifications. Items that did not correspond to the new specifications were deleted from the item pool. Future item writing assignments will be made based on an analysis of domain/topic deficiencies identified by the item inventory.

Please take special care to ensure that materials distributed to licensure candidates reflect the new test specifications that will be effective in 2017. An article reporting the 2015 Dietetics Practice Audit results will be published in the October 2016 issue of the *Journal of the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics*.

Good morning. I am emailing with a question about dietitian licensure for South Carolina. I am currently a registered dietitian with a license to practice in the state of North Carolina. I work for an organization called the East Coast Migrant Head Start Project (ECMHSP), which is the sponsoring organization for Head Start centers in multiple states, including 4 South Carolina. The organization's headquarters is based out of Raleigh, NC, which is where my office is located. As part of my job, I perform remote nutrition assessments for the children in our centers based on information entered into a computer software program. If a nutrition concern is identified (obese, underweight, etc.), I provide nutrition information to be given to parents/caregivers. My question is: even though I am based out of NC, do I need to become licensed in the state of South Carolina in order to perform the nutrition assessments for the children in our South Carolina centers?

Any information you can provide would be helpful.
