This daycare is my sister's life . She has had an excellent rating all these years. For the last year she has had a new DSS caseworker by the name of Tracey Nichols. She has been riding them so bad it is ridiculous. I am a retired nurse , I work for my sister after I retired for a few months . I had the privilege of meeting Tracey. This lady would write her up for not having a date on a baby bottle, she was dogmatic about paperwork. In the baby was potty trained she would not let the child go to the bathroom, since they were in the baby room they had to use there diaper. As we all know some children learn much faster than others. All of this petty stuff she wrote my sister up for led her not to be able to renew her license. My sister is 73 years old, this is her life. This makes the 3rd daycare this lady had closed down in Boiling Spring. DSS sent my niece a letter to appeal this , which she did. She faxed the paper back to them they are saying they never received it. They came out on Friday. My sister and myself was at the hospital our brother was dying. My niece
