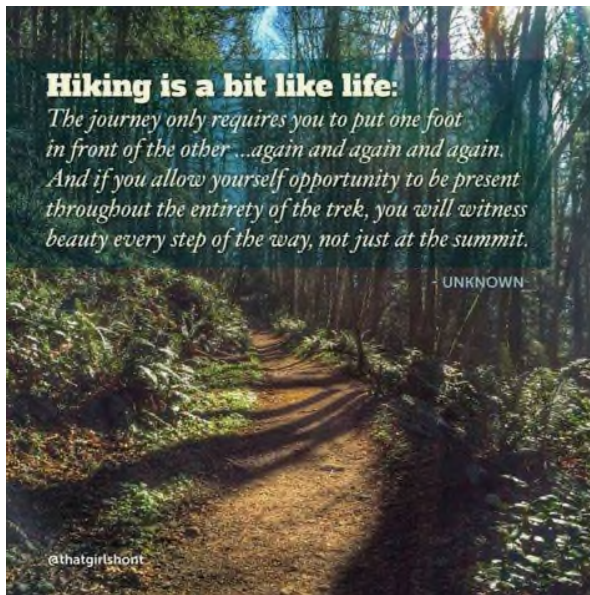

I could describe more moments: hiking the falls at Caesars Head and Table Rock, swimming at Paris Mountain, kayaking at Keowee-Toxaway and Colleton, snapping pictures of the Oconee Bells at Devils Fork, litter pickup at Lake Greenwood. So many beautiful places and so many special moments. But this isn't supposed to be a book. Thank you, South Carolina for your wonderful state parks. 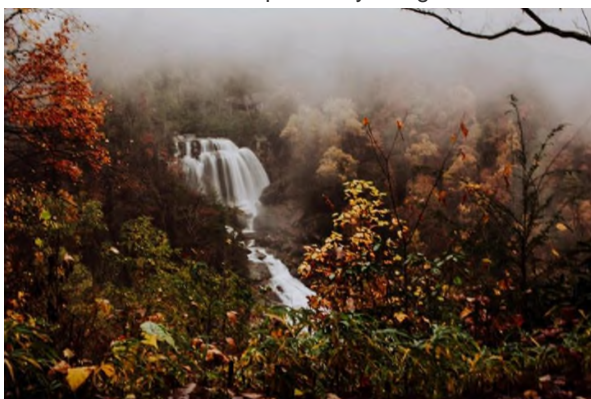

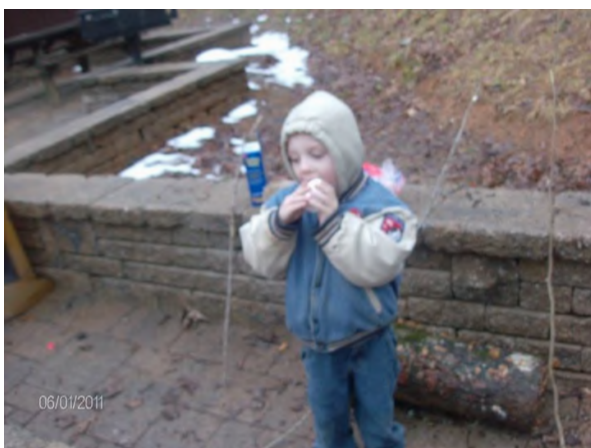

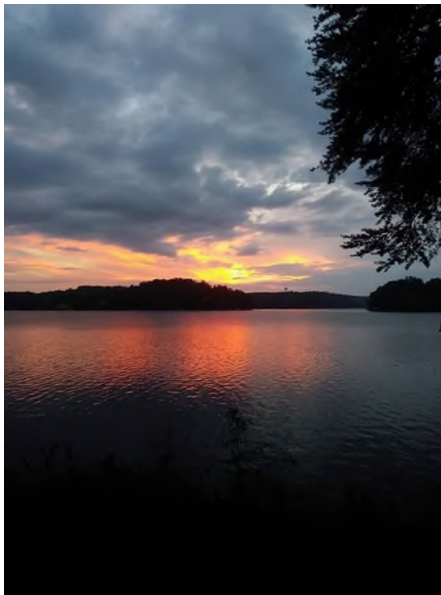
