T-Mobile USA Inc. has agreed to pay a \$7.5 million fine, \$35.5 million in consumer benefits and \$5 million to help connect low-income students following a Federal Communications Commission investigation into whether the company sufficiently disclosed constraints on speed and data in its allegedly "unlimited" plans, the FCC said Wednesday.
