Dear Ms. Curtis:

Your letter of April 14, 2014, states that the sentence of the above offender was 5 years and the chart on the second page states that he would Max Out on 9/15/2015. Craveiro was sentenced to 5 years on August 29, 2013. According to my math, he would serve until August 2018 to complete the 5 years. Even if he served only 85% of the sentence and received credit for his incarceration after arrest of 3+ months, he would serve until 2017. How can he Max Out on 9/15/2015 which would be only 2 years? If he is paroled after his hearing on May 21, he will have served a little over one year. I do not believe that is adequate punishment.

Although not a violent crime, Craveiro's burglary of my home was premeditated (his aunt and uncle had brought him to my property to do yard work) and I lost \$35,000 worth of silver flatware and jewelry, plus the cost of replacing two doors and a frame that he destroyed. He had also burgled another home in my neighborhood. I was told by the Beaufort police that this was not first offense. He had been in trouble in New York State and he is currently facing charges in Georgia, upon his release from South Carolina. Craveiro took photographs of himself and his girlfriend on the camera he stole from me and in them he was laughing. Obviously, he did not regard his offenses as serious. I still have the card on which the photos are stored. He also betrayed his aunt and uncle in Beaufort who were trying to help him by giving him work and a place to live.

I do not know Craveiro's behavior while incarcerated, but I do know that when free his behavior has been irresponsible, immature, and criminal.

I request that I be notified regarding the outcome of the hearing on May 21, 2014.
