Subject: SCDOT Secretary Hall's Storm Recovery Update

Secretary Hall's Storm Recovery Update and the Road Closure Report are attached.

State road closures are down from a peak of **541** (Oct. 5) to **73** (Nov. 19), an **87 percent** decrease. 24 highway/bridge contractors have been engaged to assist with 69 different "emergency/spot repairs" in 16 counties.

Contractors have also been engaged on 10 bridge replacement or major bridge/culvert repair projects in 4 counties.

Debris collected to date: approx. 1,900 loads (91,843 cubic yards)

13 of the remaining 73 road closures are expected to be re-opened by Thanksgiving.

8 primary routes remain closed statewide.

The majority of flood repairs have been made by in-house SCDOT maintenance forces. Below are some before/after photos of work done by SCDOT crews in Richland County.
