This letter is to notify you that the Department of Employment and Workforce (DEW) has recently made revisions to your quarterly benefit charge statements. These changes were necessary because of a computer software programming error that resulted in the failure to record all of the benefit charges for your business. This error may have affected benefit charge statements for the following time periods: Fourth Quarter of 2011, First Quarter of 2012, and Second Quarter of 2012.

Enclosed please find your revised benefit charge statement. The benefits that have not been previously charged to your account are indicated by an asterisk (*) in the far right column. The unemployment benefits were properly paid, but were not accounted for on the quarterly statements originally sent to you earlier this year.

It is important to carefully review your revised charges. Non-state agencies will receive a bill in the next several days for these undercharged benefits.

If you need additional time to make payments as a result of these revised charges, you can request up to an additional four quarters of time through our Installment Payment Plan.
