Regional Planning Request

The SCDOT Mass Transit Office requests Commission approval of the funding allocation for regional transit planning by the Council of Governments. The Appalachian COG, Lowcountry COG, and Catawba COG will use the funding to conduct transit feasibility studies for the expansion or creation of transit services within its geographic area of responsibility. The Santee Lynches COG has requested funding to upgrade the GIS based software currently being used by the RTA and coordination of regional information meetings and technical sessions. The total amount available under all open FTA Section 5313(B) grants is \$240,434.00. The total SCDOT recommendation for funding of the COGs is \$240,434.00.

1. File 23.246A / South Pleasantburg Drive Relocation / Greenville County

During construction of improvements on South Pleasantburg Drive Relocation, under File 23.246A in Greenville County, near the City of Greenville, the Department acquired right of way for South Pleasantburg Drive Relocation, by Condemnation from Jerry H. Reeves, Jr. dated August 17, 1951.

A request was received by the District Engineering Administrator from an adjacent property owner requesting to buy a parcel of South Carolina Department of Transportation right of way. The requested parcel provides a rear entrance to only two parcels which will not be affected by this action. The request was circulated to the Engineering sections to determine if said parcel could be declared surplus. After review it was determined that the parcel was surplus to Department needs. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.11 of an acre of land to T. C. Threatt, was executed on March 13, 2002.

2. File 46.546 / Interstate I-77 / York County

During construction of improvements on Interstate I-77, under File 46.546 in York County, near the Town of Fort Mill, the Department acquired right of way for Interstate I-77, by Title to Real Estate from Mary Miller dated April 24, 1969.

A request was received from the Town of Fort Mill through its engineering company requesting to construct a sewer line across a tract of SCDOT property located off the right of way of I-77. The request was circulated to the Engineering Sections to determine if the said parcel could be declared surplus. After review it was determined that the parcel was surplus to the Department's needs. Therefore a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.65 of an acre of land to The Town of Fort Mill in the consideration of \$1,000.00 was executed on March 13, 2002.

3. File 26.100A / Road S-600 (Jet Port Road) / Horry County

During construction of improvements on Road S-600 (formally Highway 707), under File 26.100A in Horry County, near City of Myrtle Beach, the Department acquired right of way for Road S-600, under the Beltline Act.

While acquiring right of way for the construction of an extension of the Robert M. Grissom Parkway, an Exchange Agreement was made between the Right of Way Department and Myrtle Beach Farms, whereas this landowner would provide new right of way needed for the Grissom Parkway in exchange for an old abandoned portion of the right of way of Road S-600 that is adjacent to the lands of the Grantee. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 4.89 acres of land to Myrtle Beach Farms Company, Inc, was executed on March 13, 2002.

4. File 26.856 / Conway Bypass / Horry County

During construction of improvements on Conway Bypass, under File 26.856 in Horry County, near the Town of Nixonville, the Department acquired right of way for Conway Bypass, by Title to Real Estate from Michael M. Edge dated December 19, 1994.

A request was received from the adjacent property owner in connection with the project named above, asking to purchase back any right of way that was acquired from him that is no longer needed. The above acquisition was acquired for right of way and 7.54 acres for a Toll Station. It was determined during construction of the Conway Bypass that the Toll Station could be eliminated from the project and the property could be sold back to the previous owner at the same price per acre that the Department paid for the land. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for a total of approximately 7.54 acres of land to Michael Marvin Edge in consideration of \$15,080.00 was executed on March 20, 2002.

5. File 13.603 / Cheraw Truck Route / Chesterfield County

During construction of improvements on The Cheraw Truck Route, under File 13.603 in Chesterfield County, near the City of Cheraw, the Department acquired right of way for The Cheraw Truck Route, by Title to Real Estate from Wannamaker Oil Inc., a South Carolina Corporation dated March 16, 1998 and from The City of Cheraw by Dedication dated June 22, 1971 under File 13.435.

While acquiring new right of way needed for the above project, the Department agreed to convey back to the Grantee, upon the completion of the project, any right of way that was not needed to maintain the road. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.08 of an acre of land to Wannamaker Oil Inc., a South Carolina Corporation was executed on March 20, 2002.

6. File 26.986 / SC Route 31 / Horry County

During construction of improvements on SC Route 31, under File 26.986 in Horry County, near the City of Myrtle Beach, the Department acquired right of way for SC Route 31, by Title to Real Estate from Long Bay Associates, a SC Partnership dated April 4, 2001.

While acquiring new right of way for the above project the Department agreed to an exchange of property with The South Carolina Public Service Authority with property for a Utility Transmission line along a portion of SC Route 31 (Carolina Bay Parkway). In exchange, the South Carolina Public Service Authority will convey new right of way to the Department. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed

for approximately 2.3 acres of land to The South Carolina Public Service Authority was executed on March 21, 2002.

7. MSC 53 / SC Route 61 / Colleton County

In order to better perform its maintenance responsibilities, the Department purchased MSC 53 in Colleton County, near the Town of Canady's Crossroad, the Department acquired Canady's Maintenance site, by Title to Real Estate from C.M. Risher, dated July 15, 1931.

The District Engineering Administrator of District 6, with concurrence of management, has determined that the Canady's Maintenance site is no longer needed and should be liquidated from the Department's inventory. The property was marketed to the general public with signs, newspaper ads, and all necessary means to attract a qualified buyer. A bid sale was set up and consummated. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.93 of an acre of land to Jane W. Ballagh in consideration of \$8,003.00 was executed on March 21, 2002.

8. File 40.774 / Interstate I-77 / Richland County

During construction of improvements on I-77, under File 40.774 in Richland County, near the City of Columbia, the Department acquired right of way by Condemnation from Mrs. Lina Mae S. Leigh and the L.A. Marsh Estate dated September 18, 1973.

An agreement was made between the Department and Richland County whereby the County would acquire right of way from the adjacent property owner and would relocate a portion of Road S-2285 (Community Road). At the completion of the construction, it was agreed that the Department would convey the abandoned portion of Road S-2285 to the adjacent property owner in consideration of the land acquired for the relocated road, which would remain in the South Carolina Department of Transportation system. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 1.89 acres of land to Leonard, Call, Taylor Investments, Inc. was executed on March 20, 2002.

9. File 40.251A/ 32.870 / I-20 & I-26 / Richland / Lexington County

During construction of improvements on I-26 & I-20, under File 40.251A / 32.870 in Richland / Lexington County, near the Town of Columbia, the Department acquired right of way for I-20 & I-26, by Condemnation from NationsBank dated April 28, 1998.

During settlement negotiations of the condemnation for tract 29, it was agreed that a right of way reduction could be made. This reduction avoided an impact to a large entrance sign for an office complex. Before the Department could finalize the settlement by amending the Condemnation Notice, the condemnee sold the property, resulting in the need for a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.1561 of an acre of land to MV Center Point LLC, an Ohio Limited Liability Company was executed on March 27, 2002.

10. MSC 34 / SC Route 97 / Chester County

In order to better perform its maintenance responsibilities, the Department purchased MSC 34 in Chester County, near the Town of Great Falls. The Department acquired the Great Falls Maintenance site, by Title to Real Estate from Lizzie R. Cousar dated August 23, 1938.

The District Engineering Administrator of District 4, with concurrence of management, has determined that the Great Falls Maintenance site is no longer needed and should be liquidated from the Department's inventory. After receiving approval from the South Carolina Budget and Control Board, the property was marketed to the general public with signs, newspaper ads, and all necessary means to attract a qualified buyer. A bid sale was set up and consummated. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 1.00 acre of land to Danny M. Plyler in consideration of \$14,900.00 was executed on March 21, 2002.

11. MSC 52 / SC Route 64 / Colleton County

In order to better perform its maintenance responsibilities, the Department purchased MSC 52 in Colleton County, near the Town of Bell's Crossroads. The Department acquired the Bell's Crossroad Maintenance site, by Title to Real Estate from Farmers & Merchants Bank, a SC Corporation dated July 18, 1931.

The District Engineering Administrator of District 6, with concurrence of management, has determined that the Bell's Crossroad Maintenance site is no longer needed and should be liquidated from the Department's inventory. After receiving approval from the South Carolina Budget and Control Board, the property was marketed to the general public with signs, newspaper ads, and all necessary means to attract a qualified buyer. A bid sale was set up and consummated. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.5 of an acre of

land to Michael A. Padgett & Mary R. Siegrist in consideration of \$2,451.00 was executed on March 27, 2002.

12. File 10.702 / Road S-171 / Charleston County

During construction of improvements on SC Route 615 (Now SC Route 171), in Charleston County, near the Town of Folly Beach, the Department acquired right of way for the old Folly Beach Road Toll Road as an access road for the construction of the new Folly Beach Road by conveyance from Charleston County dated June 9, 1943.

A request was received from the attorney representing the adjacent property owner asking the Department for a Quitclaim Deed on a small portion of the Old Folly Beach Toll Road. The courthouse records which did show the above transaction by the county that did put a cloud on the title of the requestor. The legal department agrees the matter should be cleared up on behalf of the property owner and the Department. Therefore a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.42 of an acre of land to Henry M. & Linda O. Walker was executed on April 3, 2002.


Dear Mr. Williamson:

Pursuant to the Rules and Procedures for the Pickens County Legislative Delegation, the Delegation recommends and establishes that the Pickens County Transportation Committee (PCTC) shall consist of five (5) voting members, who serve in five (5) seats, numbered one (1) through five (5), and (1) ex officio, non-voting member. The term for each PCTC member shall be a period of two (2) years, commencing January 1, and expiring December 31, of the following year. Pursuant to South Carolina law, the PCTC will make an annual report to the Delegation.


It is the intent, but not a requirement, of the Delegation that: (A) the appointees to Seats One (1) through Four (4) represent the Clemson-Central, Easley, Liberty and Pickens areas of Pickens County; (B) the appointee to Seat (5) shall be an individual employed by Pickens County in the Engineering and/or road maintenance area or his designee; and (C) the ex officio, non-voting member be the Engineer assigned to Pickens County by the South Carolina Department of Transportation or his designee.


The current voting members of the PCTC shall continue to serve on the PCTC in the designated seats as follows:


- Seat 1 B. R. Skelton of Clemson- Central area

The terms for these members shall expire December 31, 2002, and these members are eligible to be appointed to a full 2-year term commencing January 1, 2003.


The Delegation members unanimously approve this plan pursuant to weighted voting requirements and this plan is effective thirty (30) days from the date of this letter.




WHEREAS, in addition to his considerable skills at work, Mr. Yandle volunteered to work on numerous committees and projects that enhanced the reputation of SCDOT;
