

The Budget Commission met in the Governor's Office at ten o'clock, Wednesday morning, November 12, 1941. Senator Jefferies and Mr. Winchester Smith, members of the Commission, were present and Mr. John K. Cauthen represented Governor Harley.

The Commission took up for consideration requests of two farm groups, which recently met in Columbia, for contributions from the Contingent Fund to defray the expenses to Washington of delegates appointed from these groups in an attempt to secure Federal assistance for farmers in this state due to the general crop failure. One of the above groups was headed by J. Roy Jones, Commissioner of Agriculture, and the other by J. Scottowe Wannamaker of St. Matthews.

Due to the small balance remaining in the Civil Contingent Fund, the Commission was unable to grant these requests in full, but agreed to contribute to each group the sum of \$500.00 to assist in defraying the expenses of the delegates to the Washington meeting. Warrants for these contributions were approved by the Commission, and the Secretary was directed to advise each group of the Commission's action.

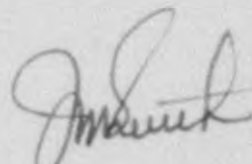
