Former Beef Ambassador Rita K. Bolt, from Anderson, was recently name president of the student body at Clemson University.

Rita was winner of the 1997 S.C. Ambassador contest and went on to win the national title and served as a spokesperson for the beef industry in South Carolina and across the nation. She is the first female ever elected president of the Clemson student body. A speech communications major, Rita grew up on a beef cattle farm and is the daughter of Ben and Gloria Bolt.

Nominating meetings for candidates to fill vacancies on the S.C. Beef Board

Pursuant to the provisions of the "Agricultural Commodities Marketing Act" and the "Marketing Order for South Carolina Beef," NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the terms of office of DISTRICT I: Ed Hutton, Pickens, DISTRICT II: Allen Beer, Richburg, DISTRICT III: Jerry Pait, Hartsville, DISTRICT IV: Carl B. Setzler, Jr., Newberry, and DISTRICT V: Ralph Bell, Jr., Summerton, members of the South Carolina Beef Board, expire on June 30, 2000, and, therefore, the five vacancies shall occur at that time.

The Commission shall call for nominations for said vacancies at nominating meetings at the times, places, and dates hereafter set forth: **District 1** - 9:00 a.m., May 16, 2000, Spartanburg TEC, Benjamin Snoddy Conference Room in the Ledbetter Administration Building, I-85 and New Cut Road, Spartanburg. **District 2** - 2:00 p.m., May 16, 2000, Chester County Clemson Extension Service Office, Court House Annex, McAliley St., Chester. **District 3** - 10:00 a.m., May 17, 2000, Darlington County Clemson Extension Service Office, 300 Russell St., Darlington. **District 4** - 10:00 a.m., May 15, 2000, Greenwood County Court House, 528 Monument St., Room 200, Greenwood. **District 5** -3:00 p.m., May 15, 2000, Columbia Farmers Market, The Dan Ramage Center, Conference Room C, 1001 Bluff Road, Columbia.

To qualify, a candidate must be a resident of South Carolina over the age of 25 years, having been engaged in producing beef within the State of South Carolina for a period of five years, and during that period, having derived a substantial portion of his income therefrom.

District 1 includes the Counties of Anderson, Cherokee, Greenville, Laurens, Oconee, Pickens, Spartanburg, and Union. District 2 includes the Counties of Chester, Fairfield, Kershaw, Lancaster and York. District 3 includes the Counties of Chesterfield, Darlington, Dillon, Florence, Georgetown, Horry, Marion, Marlboro, and Williamsburg. District 4 includes the Counties of Abbeville, Aiken, Edgefield, Greenwood, Newberry, McCormick and Saluda. District 5 includes the Counties of Calhoun, Clarendon, Lee, Lexington, Orangeburg, Richland and Sumter.

Oral nominations for qualified candidates may be made at the nominating meeting and accepted by the Commission. All oral nominations for Board vacancies must be accompanied by a second to be considered for election. Nominations may also be made within five (5) days after said meeting by written petition filed with the Commission and signed by not less than five (5) affected producers entitled to participate in such meeting. The terms of office of the members elected and/or appointed to fill said vacancies shall be three (3) years.

Referendum for continuance of the marketing order for S.C. cotton

Pursuant to the applicable rules of practice and procedure governing proceedings for continuance of marketing orders under provisions of the "Agricultural Commodities Marketing Act" of 1968, and as amended, and Marketing Order No. 12 for South Carolina Cotton issued July 6, 1990, notice is hereby given that the Agriculture Commission of South Carolina will conduct a referendum by mail among affected producers for continuance of Marketing Order No. 12 for South Carolina Cotton during the period June 1-14, 2000, as required by Section XII. Continuance: Prior to the completion of each five (5) calendar years from the effective date of this Order, the Commission shall resubmit the Order to a referendum of affected producers according to the requirements of initial assent pursuant to the Act. In the event that the required assent is not given by the affected producers, this Order shall be declared to be terminated.

The Marketing Order provides a legal framework through which a Cotton Board could act on programs of advertising and sales promotion, research and market development and other matters to achieve more orderly marketing conditions and thereby tend to achieve the declared policy of the Agricultural Commodities Marketing Act. A South Carolina Cotton Board composed of seven producer members and one ex-officio member will administer the Order.

The S.C. Department of Agriculture has just wrapped up its last of four Plant and Flower Festivals, which were held at the Greenville, Florence and Columbia State Farmers Markets as well as at the Exchange Park in Ladson. The Greenville State Farmers Market is located at 1354 Rutherford Rd., the Pee Dee State Farmers Market is located at 2513 W. Lucas St., near I-20, in Florence, and the Columbia State Farmers Market is located on Bluff Road, across from Williams-Brice Stadium.

Of course, our Certified Roadside Markets are located in every county. With more than 100 roadside markets certified by the SCDA, there is sure to be one close to you. Just look for our Certified Roadside Market emblem before you shop. That emblem assures you that you will find fresh, quality produce at the market—during any season in which the market is open.

Each year when spring arrives I am so pleased that I live in a region where everything just seems to come alive. On every road I travel, I can see corn sprouting and hay fields flourishing. Without agriculture, spring wouldn't seem nearly as spectacular. When I hear or read statistical reports about how the amount of farmland in the state is rapidly shrinking, I wonder if we fully realize what we will be missing if the trend continues. Agriculture brings us more than food and floriculture; it emphasizes to us when spring is here; it brings us spring as we know it. What a wonderful place to live—South Carolina—with four distinct seasons!
