WHEREAS, named in honor of Issaqueena, a Native American woman who, according to legend, gave the Town of Six Mile its name, the Festival is a popular area event among attendees of all ages; and

WHEREAS, the 2014 Issaqueena Festival will feature a variety of attractions including local artists and vendors, special children's activities and entertainment, and a run/walk race, Issaqueena's Flight for the Fight 6K and ½ mile Family Fun Run, whose proceeds will benefit Dabo's All In Team Foundation's Breast Cancer Research Focus Area; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Six Mile is celebrating the 25th Anniversary of the Issaqueena Festival.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim May 17, 2014, as
