SCRN: Sweepstakes machine ban now heads to governor

The South Carolina House approved a bill Wednesday which tries to clarify that devices known as “sweepstakes” machines are illegal under the state’s video gambling law. The House voted 88-26 Wednesday to close perceived loopholes that business owners use to operate what are known as “sweepstakes cafes.” The state considers the cafes to be a new incarnation of video poker. Another vote Thursday will send the bill to the governor’s desk.

Note: The Governor’s Office was evasive Wednesday on whether or not Gov. Nikki Haley would sign the bill into law, preferring to wait until it clears a final procedural vote on Thursday. “However, it’s safe to say that the governor won’t sign a bill into law that legalizes gambling in our state,” spokesman Rob Godfrey wrote in an email.

As he works for her reelection, Union County Republican Party Chairman Mike Fowler says he wants to have Gov. Nikki Haley come to Union County more often in the months ahead. Fowler is one of 164 co-chairs of the Haley campaign’s statewide grassroots steering committee. The co-chairs represent all of South Carolina’s 46 counties and Fowler is the only co-chair from Union County. As co-chair for Union County, Fowler said he will be responsible for organizing grassroots events to support Haley’s reelection bid. He said he hopes to bring Haley to Union County to campaign in the future.
