PROCLAMATION WORDING (Presenting the proclamation to ...?):

WHEREAS, heart disease is the leading cause of death among women, yet 80 percent of cardiac events can be prevented; and

WHEREAS, cardiovascular diseases cause 1 in 3 women's deaths each year, killing approximately 1 woman every minute; and

WHEREAS, an estimated 44 million women in the United States are affected by cardiovascular diseases, and 90 percent of women have 1 or more risk factors for developing heart disease, yet only 1 in 5 American women believe that heart disease is her greatest health threat; and

WHEREAS, women comprise only 24 percent of participants in all heart-related studies; and

WHEREAS, since 1984, more women than men have died each year from heart disease; and

WHEREAS, women involved with the American Heart Association's Go Red for Women

movement live healthier lives, with nearly 90 percent having made at least one healthy behavior change; and

WHEREAS, Go Red For Women helps raise awareness of the importance of empowering women to take charge of their heart health and join together to end cardiovascular disease.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim February 6, 2015, as
