In fact our letter I received says I have only the right to plead guilty or not guilty (only with the consent of the solicitor). Also in the matter of a preliminary hearing, I failed to see where probable cause was established in fact in my there was no proof established I committed such crimes as one I'm charged; only theory I was quite shocked when my Attorney did nothing at all to protect my

right not to be abridged, ect. Gov. Haley I would

at L.C.P.C. I can prove these issues? I've wrote  
I.A., F.B.I., S.H.E.D., State Supreme Court, Indigent defense,  
not one has answered me plus for justice. Keep in mind  
there are others concerned for these issues. Any way  
this is the way we see things from our perspective.  
The judge set bail too high for an indigent to afford,  
then appoints an public defender who does not even  
care to defend our due process or const rights. The  
solicitor puts off our cases for an unbreachable amount  
of time, hoping we will get tired of being in  
county and take a plea, if not your stay here gets  
even longer. This is a form of coercion to buy  
this time no one cares! Because by then everything  
we had is gone, sometimes even our loved ones abandon  
us out of hardship. I'm sure that if a proper investigation  
was done you would find (starting with Indigent  
defense) a lot of taxpayers money (S.C.'s money)  
being issued to Districts and Attorneys for doing  
nothing more than turning in a bill. I heard an  
solicitor say it's like shooting fish in a barrel and getting  
paid for it. I investigate, if we are wrong then  
I have only put my head on the chopping block, but  
we would like to bring this matter to your attention.

Please consider these opinions without prejudice, and help to insure our due process along with our const. rights are protected as well as the laws which govern S.C. law enforcement. We will all be held accountable in one way or another. I believe a people will only imitate its leaders, also CROSS BLOODS CROSS! I will tell you this Gov. Haley, the man whom I am accused of murdering did come after me even when I went into my own home. I had every intent of taking my life.
