The mission of the Export-Import Bank (Ex-Im) is to support American jobs by financing the export of U.S. goods and services. By filling gaps in private sector financing, Ex-Im levels the playing field for U.S. exporters—and does so at no cost to American taxpayers. The Bank receives a “net zero” appropriation from Congress, and generates revenue through interest and fees we charge our customers. I am pleased to announce that in September, Ex-Im sent \$675 million of excess revenues to the Treasury to be used for deficit reduction.

Attached is our monthly export report showing those businesses—small and large—in your state that received financing support from Ex-Im. Additionally, I encourage you to visit our website at www.exim.gov which provides greater detail on the tools available to help American businesses grow through exports.
