MINUTES OF STATE BUDGET AND CONTROL BOARD MEETING

JULY 7, 1961

The State Budget and Control Board met in the Office of the State Auditor on July 7, 1961 at 11:00 A. M. All members of the Board were present except Governor Hollings and Senator Brown.

The purpose of this meeting was to consider a number of salary lists for the fiscal year 1961-1962, among which were the following:

The State Hospital
The Mental Health Commission
Whitten Village
The State Library Board
The S. C. School for the Deaf and the Blind
The State Department of Education
The Water Pollution Control Authority
The State Board of Health

The Board studied these salary lists and gave its approval to all of them with certain exceptions. The State Auditor was instructed to advise the respective agencies of the exceptions and of the compensation which was approved in these cases.

Among the exceptions was the Board's approval of \$20,000.00 total compensation annually for the Superintendent of the State Hospital, and \$16,500.00 annually for the Director of the Mental Health Commission.

The Board approved the employment of a psychiatrist to be employed on a part-time basis by the Richland County Mental Health Commission and for the remainder of his time at the State Hospital. The total compensation of this official to be \$19,000.00 per annum.

Other matters were discussed generally by the Board but no definite action was taken on any other such matters.

The Board then adjourned.
