~~After~~ A number was out that the Electric Company, Duke Energy was giving customers letter with the date we had no service to take to DSS in Lincoln County.

DSS Message to us only the people
that had a food EBT Card would
get $\frac{1}{2}$ of their monthly amount
added to their Card.

Really, some people power on
EBT (power was NOT out.)

So what type of help is there
for Seniors that for 6 days
without power, to replace our
food and money we had to use
to survive for six day buying
food, Candles water, was trying
to find a store with food.

I Check FEMA and there
is Nothing to Cover our Loss.

So disappointed in your Office
and FEMA you all forgot about
the Seniors.
