- WHEREAS,** most older adults who need daily assistance want to remain in their homes and communities, an alternative that is generally less expensive than nursing home care and less likely to require public assistance; and
- WHEREAS,** family caregivers provide care and assistance with the activities of daily life at great cost to their own physical, financial, and emotional health; and
- WHEREAS,** Family Caregivers Month provides an opportunity to honor our family caregivers while raising awareness of the support and encouragement they need to carry out their vital responsibilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim November 2016 as

throughout the state and encourage all South Carolinians to recognize, support, and celebrate the valuable role family caregivers across the Palmetto State play in the lives of our residents.
