Resource 0504 is a vacant farmhouse with outbuildings located on a 59-acre former agricultural parcel that now contains a solar project. The main farmhouse is a significantly altered circa-1890 one-story vernacular dwelling with a side-gable roof clad in standing seam metal, a clapboard exterior, a brick pier foundation with concrete block infill, and a rear shed-roof addition. Built across the original façade of the house is a circa-1950 addition with a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles and a clapboard exterior. Outbuildings include a circa-1940 one-story house, wood frame sheds, and a pole barn.
