**Taxpayer Cost: \$200,000**

### **Background Information:**

Osprey Village is a non-profit incorporated in 2008 at the home address of its founder – David Green – a web developer in Bluffton.

The intent of the village to provide housing and community support to individuals with disabilities.

**Osprey Village does not exist – it has remained a concept since its inception seven years ago.**

According to tax filings (attached), the organization raised \$182,364 from private donations, memberships, and grants from 2009-2013 – less than the total amount this earmark will provide the organization in a single year.

A thrift store in Bluffton was established to help fund the project, but has yielded little fruit – gross

proceeds for the same five year period were less than \$350,000.
