Commissioner's Column

A month for the heart

February is a month for matters of the heart and for the heart. On Feb. 14, we celebrate St. Valentine's Day, when we traditionally have lots of chocolates and high-calorie dinners. But, February is also American Heart Month, and many people are searching for ways to make their diets a little healthier (and still have a few chocolates).

It seems as if the 90s was the "Health Decade." But many people who wanted to eat healthier just found it to be a confusing decade, as health officials would claim some foods could lead to heart disease, then say those same foods could reduce the risk for heart disease—all within a matter of months! Fortunately, while health-related research continues, the myths about what to eat have somewhat stabilized, and it's no longer such a confusing task to eat well and to eat for wellness. In fact, we can simply look at South Carolina's own commodities to keep us healthy.

As recently as October of last year, the Food and Drug Administration gave the go-ahead to allow food labels that highlight the health benefits of soybeans on certain soy products. The labels will note the link between eating soy protein and a reduced risk of heart disease. This was a major victory for South Carolina's soybean industry. We've known for some time that eating soy products results in many health benefits, and now our food labels can state it!

Studies also show that South Carolina's peanuts are good for your heart. Peanuts and peanut butter are naturally cholesterol free, and contain mostly mono- and polyunsaturated fats, which have been shown to lower LDL-cholesterol levels in the blood. In fact, according to the American Peanut Council, people who frequently eat peanuts may have a reduced risk of heart attack. Because of this, peanuts (and legumes) should be eaten four-to-five times per week as a part of a healthy, balanced diet.

Peanuts are also good for people who wish to lose weight. Studies show that low-fat diets are not necessarily the best way to lose weight. What people must notice is the type of fats they are ingesting. Eating monounsaturated fats can actually cut the risk of heart disease—by 20-25 percent. It's foods that are high in saturated fats that are not as healthy and cause weight gain. Researchers at Penn State have shown that people can lose weight on a higher fat diet as effectively as those on a low fat diet—as long as they are "good" fats. Peanut butter, peanuts and mixed nuts all contain "good fats."

Peanuts, of course, aren't the only source of these "good fats." Quality South Carolina beef and pork, if prepared properly, can also be a part of a heart-healthy diet. The American Heart Association tells us that we should properly balance the types of fats we eat, including saturated fats (in moderate amounts). During the last decade, consumers demanded meats lower in saturated fat, and the meat industry responded with leaner cuts of beef and pork. Leaner animals are now being produced and retail meat is better trimmed than it was in the 1970s and 80s—meats now have 27-to-50 percent less trimmable fat than before. Poultry has also become healthier. That's because consumers realize that trimming poultry fat and removing the skin from poultry greatly reduces its fat content.

Healthy living isn't synonymous with giving up the foods we love. The key is a balanced diet and exercise. We simply need to pay attention to how lean our cuts of meat are and how we prepare our foods. We can also improve our health by eating soy products, peanuts, legumes, and fruits and vegetables. So perhaps this year, Valentine's Day dinner can be both from the heart and for the heart!
