WHEREAS, tragically, many children do not receive the supportive environments needed to promote healthy development and learning; and

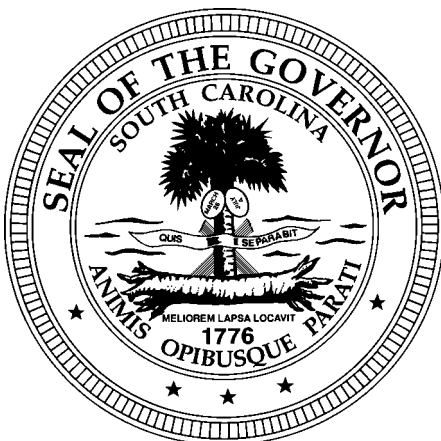
