This vehicle has a former assembly member tag FL103. She waited as long as she could and then both of them had to climb over the passenger seats to get in the car. I know this seems like a pretty minor incident, but it isn't when you are 9 months pregnant, it's extremely difficult and borderline dangerous. It's also discouraging that an elected official disregards societal norms to such a degree. Add to that the tag, which I assume means they are exempt from the registration fees the rest of us pay, is even more frustrating. I would like to know who this car belongs to.
