New Bills to Track:

- HP – Planned Parenthood (4538) – HP will begin tracking.
- HP/RS – Magistrates (4457; 4665) – DM wants to meet with us regarding the Governor’s authority to appoint magistrates regardless of the Senate’s nomination. RS will send separate email with background.
- RS – Alimony (3019; 4029) – RS is assigned to track these bills and will do one-pagers on each; NH asked for HP’s opinions on the bills the next time we meet.
- RS – Medical Marijuana (3140; 4037; 672) – RS will begin tracking.
