On the motion of Mr. Wright, seconded by Mr. Wiles, Council voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the May 20 and May 22 meetings as mailed.

Mr. Robert P. Lusk, County Attorney, presented Ordinance #55 (Fort Hill Cable TV Franchise) for first reading. On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Wright, Council voted unanimously to adopt on first reading.

Mr. Robert M. Gallant advised Council of the availability of the Social Security Building. Council agreed to give Mr. Gallant some decision by Wednesday, June 4, 1980.

Mr. David Watson advised Council of radio maintenance for the Sheriff's Office and EMS. On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Rhodes, Council voted unanimously to extend the contracts to Morris Communications and Communications Service Center for another year (1980-81 FY) at the same rates.

Mr. Robert P. Lusk presented Ordinance #52 - EMS for third and final reading. On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Wiles, Council voted unanimously to adopt on third and final reading - Ordinance #52. Mr. Lusk read Ordinance #53 (ANATS) for the third and final time. On the motion of Mr. Wiles, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council voted unanimously to adopt Ordinance #53. Mr. Lusk presented Ordinance #54 (West Pelzer Cable TV Franchise) for second reading. On the motion of Mr. Wright, seconded by Mr. Rhodes, Council voted unanimously to adopt on second reading.

Mr. Poore advised Council of a letter from Mr. Carl Stone for Mrs. Eleanor Farmer for re-appointment to the Library board. On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Wright, Council voted unanimously to re-appoint Mrs. Eleanor Farmer to this board.

Mr. Ray Sanders approached Council concerning Pioneer Lane and Lakewood Lane. On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Gerrard, Council voted unanimously to go ahead and repair this road sometime between now and the beginning of school.

On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council voted unanimously to adjourn at 9:20 a.m.
