

**CITY OF CAYCE
Special Meeting
October 7, 2005**

A Special meeting of Cayce City Council was held at 9:00 a.m. in the Conference Room at City Hall. Those present included Mayor Avery B. Wilkerson, Jr., Councilmen Rick Myers, James Jenkins, Kenneth Jumper, and Robert Malpass, City Manager John C. Sharpe, and Tammy Barkley, Municipal Clerk. Mayor Wilkerson advised that members of the press and the public were duly notified of the meeting in accordance with the FOIA.

Mayor Wilkerson opened the meeting with the invocation and led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Executive Session

A. Receipt of Legal Advice – Brookland Cayce High School Rezoning
