FGI:

GKN Meeting: Mr. Bill Beard is available to meet with the Governor at Wexford between 1-2pm on Thursday. What time do we confirm? Gregg Robinson (Orangeburg Co. Economic Developer) will be bringing Mr. Beard (in case those names need to be added for the front gate). Also, since the Secretary is playing in FGI, we will have Ford Graham sit in that meeting. I will forward this meeting brief shortly, but this is an expansion, 79 jobs and \$28M in Orangeburg.

Magna Meeting: Mr. Frank Ervin is also amenable to a brief meeting with the Governor following FGI. Will this be a scheduled time? This brief is forthcoming, but the project is \$50M and 150 jobs looking at Greenville. This meeting brief forthcoming.

Fuji (congrats convo ~3 min): Mr. Todd Croker is playing in FGI, and we would like to arrange a brief conversation for the Governor to congratulate Mr. Croker on recently being named President of Fuji Manufacturing USA. I will send a short briefing for this conversation, but do we

confirm a time or is this one we work in? Will send short brief of details.

Project Cloud (MPW Services – brief intro ~1-2 min): If there is an opportunity to speak to Tim Dondero (literally an introduction – as he is not the ultimate decision maker), that would be great as this is an active project. We're putting together brief project details for these short intros.

PSR:

Project Flower (Orchids Paper – welcome convo ~3-4 min): This project is scheduled to announced April 20th, and Mr. Jeff Schoen (President & CEO) is attending PSR. It would be timely for a brief conversation for the Governor to congratulate and welcome the company. We will have a short brief for this as well.

Project Jacket (ProBrass - ~1 min): This project is \$31M and 71 jobs in Clarendon. While it's premature for a sit-down, we would like to briefly introduce Christopher Moe (CEO) and Tim Baxter (COO) to the Governor. Short brief to follow.

Project Union (Universal Aerospace - ~1 min): This is a brand new project. Several members of their team will attend PSR, and we would like to make a very brief introduction. Short brief to follow.

Project Monaco (Impresa Aerospace - ~1 min): This is also a brand new project. We are gathering details to include in the short brief to follow, but we would like to introduce their two representatives briefly to the Governor.
