The South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) has scheduled a ribbon-cutting ceremony today, Monday, Oct. 17, 2016, to officially reopen Devils Backbone Road in Lexington County. This road was damaged in the 1,000-year flood of October 2015.

The ceremony will be held at 5:30 p.m. on Devils Backbone Road at the site of the repairs.

Scheduled speakers include Secretary of Transportation Christy Hall, SCDOT Chief Engineer for Operations Andy Leaphart and South Carolina State Senator Katrina Shealy (District 23).

Directions from Columbia:

- Take US-1 S toward Batesburg-Leesville.
- Merge Right onto SC-23.
- In approximately 2 miles, turn right onto SC-245
- In approximately 2.2 miles, turn right onto Devils Backbone Road. Project is less than 1 mile from intersection of SC-245.
