The time is now to make arrangements to attend the summer meeting of the SC Beekeepers Association to be held on July 11-13, 2002 at the Poole Agricultural Building Auditorium, Clemson University in Clemson, SC.

Meeting registration at the door will begin at 12 noon on Thursday, July 11, and the meeting will end at noon on Saturday, July 13. Registration fee for association members is \$3 (\$5 for family) and for non-members is \$8.

The meeting will begin at 1 pm on Thursday with an introductory beekeeping short course. Dr. David De Jong, Professor of Genetics and Evolution at the University of Sao Paulo, Brazil, will be the featured speaker. Dr. De Jong will give presentations on the Africanized HoneyBee, Varroa Mites, and Hive Medicinal Products used in Brazil. He will also lead in an afternoon workshop further discussing these topics. Other speakers will give presentations and workshops that are of much interest to beekeepers or anyone interested in honeybees.

Friday evening activities include a chicken barbecue dinner (\$6/plate), horseshoe pitching contest and a tall tales contest.

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Commissioner's Column

Generations of Farming Fathers

Father's Day has a special meaning for first cousins, Ricky Kneece of Pelion and Luther Kneece of Gilbert. Their fathers, Delano and Everett, respectfully, inherited the family farm from their father, Noah Kneece. To the Kneeces, family and community are their devotion, but farming is their passion.

The fathers and sons crop or sharecrop corn, cotton, and peanuts on about 2,000 acres, 95-98% of which is irrigated. Some of their corn is sold to Allen Brothers Milling Company in Columbia for Adluh cornmeal, but most of it is sold to a pet food company in Orangeburg and to area chicken farms for feed.

Ricky Kneece and his wife have two sons—one a recent graduate of Pelion High School who has a fondness for raising livestock and the other a rising 10th grader who is more interested in row crops. The boys are hard workers like their father. Ricky now has three separate farms under his supervision. He does all the planting himself, but his father, Delano, still works the farm as much as possible, and Luther helps out when he can.

Ricky's wife says, "He works on the farm every day of the year. There's no off season. When planting and harvesting are over, he's catching up with equipment repairs." Ricky said, "I worked on the farm after school during the school year and all day on the farm during the summer. It's my life!"

Ricky's cousin, Luther Kneece, and his wife have two daughters—one who is about to begin Clemson to major in Business Administration and the other who is the most likely candidate to find a career that involves the outdoors. Luther is President and General Manager of PBT (Pond Branch Telephone Company), a family owned business in Gilbert. In 1962, Luther's grandfather needed help, so Luther's dad, Everett, quit farming with his brother, Delano, to manage the telephone company. When touted for being so progressive, Everett said, "I've always believed that people in rural areas should have the same opportunities as people in the city."

Luther remembers the electromagnetic (magneto) telephone. He said, "I equate the magneto with the wooden telephone on the television show, *Green Acres*." With Luther at the helm today, PBT now provides DSL (digital subscriber line), cable, and other modern services to the community. But, his first love is his farming. Luther's wife said he's been involved in farming and the family business since he could barely walk. While attending the University of South Carolina, Luther raised about 80 head of cattle, farmed 200-250 acres, and worked at the telephone company. After one year, Luther transferred to Midlands Tech where he graduated with an Associate Degree in Electronic Engineering. "But," he said, "all the training and experience I've had through the years could add up to several degrees." They say that experience is the best teacher. Today, Luther is deeply involved with the local schools, providing scholarships and other services like wiring for Internet connections.

Through the years, the fathers and sons have remained not only partners in their business operations, but they've stayed the best of friends. Delano and Everett gained a work ethic from their father, Noah. They passed that work ethic on down to their sons, Ricky and Luther. Now, Ricky and Luther are passing that same work ethic on to their children. Parents, in this case, fathers who demonstrate a strong work ethic, tend to impart a strong work ethic to their children. Ricky said, "We tell them to work hard. Do whatever you want to do in life. Do whatever you enjoy doing, but do the best that you can. If you don't enjoy what you do, you won't be successful in life."

To the Kneece fathers—first, second, and third generations—thank you for your dedication to fatherhood and to family. Thank you for your service to your community through the family business and farming. Whether your children call you "Daddy," "Father," "Pop," "Pappy," or "Poppa"—to those who are fathers like the Kneeces and to those who have acted as father figures in someone's life,
