Would you kindly remember our interaction during your visit to Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar in November 2014. It looked very nice to interact with you and your respected husband Michael Haley Jr.

I am writing you this email for your consideration and favourable support for getting my daughter, Dr. Shubhpreet Kaur, Employment Visa. The case of my daughter is given below in detail. This request has also been sent via email to your revered father S. Ajit Singh Randhawa Ji.

My daughter, Shubh Kaur MD, did her residency in Internal Medicine from Rochester (New York) and completed her fellowship from the University of Arizona-2014 and is a board certified Endocrinologist in Tucson, Arizona.

She currently has an offer from a local non-profit organization Tucson Medical Centre (TMC) which has spent a great deal of financial and logistical resources to set up her clinic to serve the community in desperate need of medical services to help with their varied medical conditions. The non-profit, Tucson Medical Center (TMC), employs a large number of physicians and also serves as a center of education with residents and fellows from the University of Arizona doing their clinical rotations in Tucson Medical Centre (TMC) for their training.

For reasons not well understood, the USCIS has raised objection for my daughter for granting her work visa and work in TMC. They are not recognizing TMC as a non-profit and a center of higher education despite a number of physicians working there under that category. My daughter has completed her residency in Internal Medicine & Fellowship in Endocrinology in the USA on H1B visa and has no legal issues or wrongdoing of any kind and is a very committed and dedicated Doctor serving humanity.

On her personal front, I would like to share with you that for Dr. Shubhpreet, job in TMC is very important since her husband will be finishing his Fellowship in Pulmonary Critical Care from University of Arizona, Tucson in 2016. Shifting from Tucson is very difficult. Shubhpreet has a small daughter of two years who needs support of both parents. I am sure your timely help will be a great assistance in getting Employment Visa for Dr. Shubhpreet who is professionally also a very deserving candidate.

Tucson Medical Center has extended full support to Dr. Shubhpreet Kaur's employment and her legal team is trying their best for her work visa, without success. I would like to bring to your notice that many doctors under the H1B category in TMC were given Cap Exemption by USCIS in the past but it is not being done in Shubhpreet's case. Her employment and green card is already being processed through TMC.

Your assistance in this matter, to help her obtain an employment visa, will be greatly appreciated. I will be highly obliged for your kind assistance to my daughter for getting her employment visa.
