

Vermont law permits an individual to contribute as much as \$4,000 to a candidate for state office. A couple may contribute as much as \$8,000. Unlike federal elections, contributions to state candidates may also be made (up to \$4,000) by associations, limited liability companies, business partnerships and corporations. However, in all cases political contributions are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes.
