- **Dr. Amir Ullah Khan:** A Development Economist, Visiting Faculty at ISB and Advisor to the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, he will create an understanding of the Indian Economy & Industry Sector Trends and Indian Political Environment
- **Mr. Porus Munshi:** As the founder of Making Breakthroughs Happen, he will take the participants through the Realities of Innovation in Emerging Markets
- **Mr. Ramkumar S:** CEO, Last Resort Consulting, and Visiting Faculty at ISB and IIM, Kashipur, he will address the challenges of Marketing at the Bottom of the Pyramid, and chart out marketing approaches for new market opportunities in India
- **Prof. Dishan Kamdar:** He's the Deputy Dean – Programmes and Professor of Organisational Behaviour at the ISB, and will introduce participants to the intricacies of negotiating in the Indian context
