Dear Mr. Summers,

Please forgive the anonymity, but I would definitely encounter highly negative, perhaps dangerous, repercussions if the party I am writing to you about were to know my identity.

A man by the name of Robert Oxendine, who has lived at 233 Partridge Lane, North, South Carolina 29112 for the past fifteen years, has never paid any vehicle taxes for his truck. His Dodge Ram truck, white in color, year 2002 – 2004 with chrome bumper guard and rear window guard, has a Florida license plate, X68-ZZR, Sunshine State. Mr. Oxendine has resided in North since about the year 2000. He visits Florida maybe one or two days a year to renew his license plate. This situation has been reported about six months ago to the South Carolina Highway Patrol as well as to Orangeburg County Police. No one has done anything about it. When speaking with other residents, Mr. Oxendine makes no secret that he is getting away with not paying his taxes regarding his vehicle.

She has North Carolina license plates XPT-9960 on her gray or silver colored vehicle. She pays no taxes in Orangeburg County either, although she uses County resources for her husband, who is ill, for which other people pay with their taxes.

Mr. Oxendine pleads his wife's health issues and his age to excuse his behavior. He has gotten away with this dishonesty for the past fifteen years. No one seems to do anything about certain residents of this county who do not pay their taxes while others have to carry this extra tax burden on their own limited finances. Everyone should have to pay their fair share of taxes, including Mr. Oxendine.
